

## REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

1. Fill out your Course Selection work sheet PRIOR to logging on to the computer. The registration times out after 10 minutes. Your requests will not be saved if you do not submit them within that time frame. You will also need to make sure you have a complete schedule (7.5 credits) or it will not be saved. REMEMBER TO SUBMIT!
2. Registration information, including a complete Course Selection Guide, is available online by following the Guidance link at [www.springlakeschools.org](http://www.springlakeschools.org). You will need your school ID using lower case sn before the number and then the password you normally use at school. (example: sn20154 and STrR2D)
3. Double check prerequisites. DO NOT sign up for a class you are not eligible to take.
4. Choose electives carefully.
5. For alternative classes, list only one term elective classes that you are willing to take. You might not be placed in your requested electives.
6. REMEMBER TO SUBMIT!
7. Bring completed 4-year Course Selection sheet to your scheduled counselor appointment.

### CLASS OF 2011

1. Make sure you have taken at least 2 terms of fine arts (*all art classes, band, choir, all computer classes, school pub, all vocational classes, creative writing, drama classes, approved Careerline Tech courses, approved MVHS classes, approved independent study classes*)
2. You must take math. It can be a standard math class (*Trig A & B, Alg. II A & B, etc.*), Accounting I A & B, or a two-term combination of Finance, Statistics, or Advanced Accounting. Physics A & B may also count as a 12<sup>th</sup> grade math class only if you don't need it for a science credit.
3. Indicate which contemporary history class you want to take: contemporary history lecture or the regular contemporary history class. (*Tech Center students are not eligible for the lecture version of this class.*)
4. If you haven't done so as a junior, you must take the A section of either Chemistry I or Physics. If you are a college bound student, you should take a full year of at least one of these classes.

5. Students who plan to return to the Careerline Tech Center may select the second year of their current program. Work Keys Read/Math should be added 3 times as it is part of the tech center program.

### **CLASS OF 2012**

1. Check with your English II teacher for 11<sup>th</sup> grade English placement.
2. You MUST take the A section of either Chemistry I or Physics. College bound students should take a full year of either class.
3. You MUST take World History and Academic Collegiate Transitions.

Enter regular classes for now. Tech Center will be added later once your application has been approved and a slot reserved for you.

### **CLASS OF 2013**

1. Sign up for Intro to Physics and Intro to Chemistry. If you qualify for Chemistry I as a sophomore, the class will be added later.
