This is an excellent source of financial support. **The deadline is March 5, 2010**, and you MUST have filled out the FAFSA form to complete the application. Start the application TODAY!!

**The American Legion Post 28** is offering the **Gene Rothi Scholarship**. You must be the descendent of a Post 28 member. Other selection criteria include above average high school records and plans to attend college within one year of high school graduation. Applications are in the Guidance Office. **The deadline is April 16, 2010.**

**Going to Michigan? The Michigan Alpha Chapter** is offering **Phi Epsilon Balanced Man Scholarships** of \$500 and \$1, 000. Selection criteria include: being male, leadership, extracurricular activities, and community involvement. **The American Legion Auxiliary** has three scholarships available to children or grandchildren of veterans. The National President's Scholarship is worth between \$1,500 and \$2,500. The Memorial Scholarship and the Medical Career Scholarship are worth \$500 each and they must be used in Michigan. **The deadline for these scholarships is March 1, 2010.** Get your application the Guidance office today!

Other selection criteria include involvement in extracurricular or community activities and good academic standing. Selection criteria include academic achievement, extra-curricular involvement, and school/community service. **Two letters of recommendation are also required.** These scholarships vary from year to year, but usually range from \$750-\$1,000. **The deadline is February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2010.**

Interested in Law Enforcement or Criminal Justice? The Ottawa County Sheriff's Association is offering the **Deputy David Lee Steenwyk Scholarship**. It's worth up to \$4,000. Applications are in the Guidance Office. **The deadline is March 5, 2010.**

**The Michigan Oil and Gas Producers Educational Foundation (MOGPEF)** is offering scholarships worth a minimum of \$500 to students who are pursuing a degree in a field of study which will allow them to obtain full time employment in the crude oil and natural gas industry. A minimum 3.0 gpa is required and financial need is a consideration.
