

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON INCREASING PROPERTY TAXES FOR
SPRING LAKE PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE The Board of Education of Spring Lake Public Schools will hold a public hearing on a proposed increase of 0.2416 mill in the non-homestead operating tax millage rate to be levied in 2021.

The hearing will be conducted by the Spring Lake Public Schools Board of Education on Monday, November 15, 2021, at 6:45, p.m., at Spring Lake Middle School Media Center, 345 Hammond St, Spring Lake, MI 49456.

The hearing relates to the levy of Spring Lake Public Schools' 18 mills non-homestead operating millage, which millage was approved at the November 2, 2021 election.

The Board of Education meeting to take action on the proposed additional millage will directly follow this public hearing.

If adopted, the proposed additional millage will increase operating revenues from ad valorem taxes 1.34% over such revenues generated by levies permitted without holding a hearing. If the proposed additional millage rate is not approved, the operating revenue will increase by 2.66% over the preceding year's operating revenue.

The taxing unit publishing this notice, and identified below, has complete authority to establish the number of mills to be levied from within its authorized operating millage rate.
