

FAFSA Instructions:

1). FSAID (Student and Parent ids for FAFSA)

You and one of your parents will need a FAFSA ID in order to apply for federal financial aid. Only ONE parent needs to have an ID and complete the parent part of the FAFSA

2). FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid):

Steps to completing a FAFSA:

-Go to this website: <https://fafsa.ed.gov>

-Click Log In.

-Click “I am the student” (always click “I am the student” every time you log in).

-Log in with your FSAID information.

-Work through each page and answer the questions.

-When you get to the page that says “I will provide parent information” – your parent will take over. (Only ONE

parent needs to do this – it will be the parent who has a FSAID).

-Your parent and you will be able to use the “Data Retrieval Tool” to link to the IRS – this will automatically fill in the

financial information that is needed on the FAFSA.

-You and your parent will electronically sign and submit the FAFSA.

IMPORTANT – If you have TIP (tuition incentive program) you must complete a FAFSA to receive TIP tuition assistance.

-There is no deadline for FAFSA, but if you do not complete it by the time classes begin in the fall – you will not be able to get the TIP and FAFSA tuition assistance in time to pay for the fall.
