

98c Learning Loss Plan

Spring Lake Public Schools

What is 98c?

- Part of PA (public act) 144 of 2022 (MCL 388.1698c)-Michigan
- Part of Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) and part of the federal Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief plan (ESSER II)
- These are residual funds that were not originally distributed by the State

Plan Requirements

- Must address learning loss
- Must be presented to the board
- Must be posted to the LEA website by October 30, 2022
- Must report on progress by August, 2023

The plan for Spring Lake Public Schools

- SLPS will use funds to expand/enhance evidence based practices in tier 1 instruction, tier 2 instruction and tier 3 instruction. This includes maintaining and training (where needed) certified staff, as well as specialized staff, to carry out all three levels of instruction (Tiers 1-3)
- Primary use of funds will be to Implement evidence based practices to meet the comprehensive needs of students using the subgroup formula (ESSER III Template) for all students lagging in academic performance
- The SLPS 98c budget includes a comprehensive formula as prescribed in ESSER II & ESSER III related to learning loss

- Program progress will be measured by tracking three phases of student data from the i-Ready diagnostic assessment in math and reading
- Spring Lake Public Schools will comply with all state and federal guidelines for reporting
